

**New Classes Offered in the Chinese School (2007 Spring)**  
**(Remember: First day of the Chinese School is 1/7, the coming Sunday!)**



Special Chinese Class (周六中文夜校): Have you concerned your children missing Chinese School due to conflicting schedules on Sunday afternoon? Don't worry! The Chinese School will continue to offer Chinese classes on Saturday late afternoon (4:30 – 6:30 pm) in the CCC building to enroll children who can't attend the Sunday Chinese School due to different activities. Chess Class: The Chinese School will continue to provide Chess class taught by two young instructors. The class time will still be from 3:00 – 4:00 pm at the Sunday Chinese School. Please register this class at the first day of the school if you are interested.

SAT Review Course: Has your child started to prepare SAT? Do you want your children to learn some strategies on SAT preparation? This is a class (at Sunday Chinese School) for students who are in 7<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> grade. This course (taught by Miss. Lu Chen) will familiarize students with the format of the test, provide tips and test-taking strategies to maximize score. The main focus of the course will be to provide practice opportunities for each of the three sections (Math, Critical Reading and Writing), and to target specific problem areas through practice and help students to improve in areas of weakness. The required "essay" (part of Writing) will not be covered in this course.

Painting Class III (绘画班 II): Since Teacher Lefu Gu can't continue to teach this coming Spring in the Chinese School, another outstanding artist, Ms. Ren Liang will be the art teacher for this class in this Spring semester. Teacher Liang will come from New York City to Albany every 2 weeks to teach this class at the CCC building from 3:15 – 5 pm every other Sunday (starting 1/21/07, then 2/4, 2/25, 3/11, 3/25, 4/15, 4/29, and 5/6). All students who will register for the Art II class should aware this change and follow this new schedule. Teacher Liang will teach **Basic Drawing Technique (基本绘画技巧)** as well as Water Color technique. Teacher Liang was formally trained in painting and fine art, and she was a well known artist in NYC.

Math Class (趣味数学班): Mathematics has structure and beauty just like the visual and musical arts. It is influenced by and affects our culture and history. Ms. Aiping Chen will continue teach “**Math enrichment class**” (趣味数学) for young children in the Chinese school every Sunday. This class will demonstrate how mathematics touches, inspires, and guides our everyday life. It will stimulate and help our children develop their problem solving skills.

CCC Winter Interim Session starts in January 2007. Teacher Ginger Lin, an excellent and well known Chinese Teacher, will teach Chinese as Foreign Language and Teacher Ren Liang will teach basic drawing and Water Color classes in the CCC building.
